# **BERVIE BRAES ROAD (DF)**

Nothing further to add – awaiting response from Aberdeenshire Council

The Bervie Braes Road Project is mentioned in the STP's Business Plan 2012 – 2015 and was also included in the Community Plan. There was also a comment in PfR that there should be better access for walkers and cyclists on Bervie Braes.

#### **PLAN B**

This project will be looked at again in January 2017

The Plan B Project has been initiated as it was in STP's Business plan **SPORT AND LEISURE FACILITIES AT THE RECREATION GROUND SITE** – investigating the possibility of improved facilities at this site, alongside reviewing alternative locations. There were also a number of comments made by residents in the PfR exercise about this area of Stonehaven.

### **FUTURE OF STONEHAVEN COURT HOUSE BUILDING (DF)**

Scottish Courts and Tribunal Services have bumped the Business Plan from 4 committee meetings. Their next meeting is to be held on 20<sup>th</sup> September. This has delayed some funding by 3 months which will have to be reapplied for. The delay will enable more work to be carried out by STP.

This project falls into a number of STP's charity criteria. For example to assist in the regeneration of the area through the improvement of the physical, social and economic environment in order to:

- Manage community land and associated assets for the benefit of the Community and the public in general;
- Advance Community development, including urban or rural regeneration within the community:
- Advance environmental protection or improvement including preservation, sustainable
  development and conservation of the natural environment, the maintenance, improvement or
  provision of environmental amenities for the community and /or the preservation of buildings
  or sites of architectural, historical or other importance to the community.

### IMPROVING OUR TOWN CENTRE (JS) (Including the Board walk and Harbour Illuminations)

This project commenced due to comments that were made by residents at the PfR exercises. Comments were made about Town Centre signage, the appearance and upkeep of some of the buildings in the Centre and the seagull nuisance.

This project resulted from comments made in the PfR exercises about the lack of parking in Stonehaven in general and specifically the lack of parking in the Auld Toon during busy times.

### LAND TRAIN (MW)

The Stonehaven Land Train has taken over 5000 passengers on the tour this year and is still taking bookings from groups. This year has been a great success.
